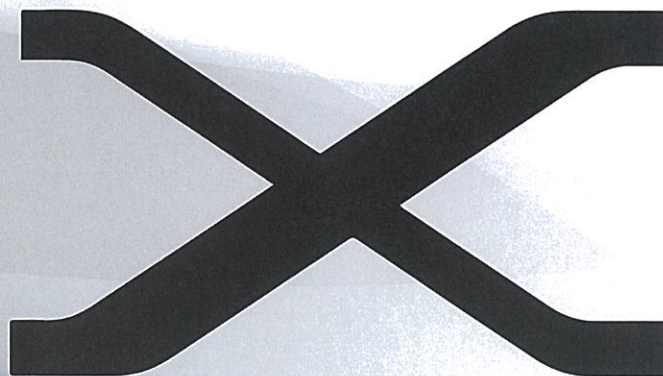

FUJIFILM LENS LOAN PROGRAMME

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1. Purpose of Fujifilm Lens Loan Program:

To encourage new users to loan and try Fujifilm's range of X-series lenses.

2. Where to loan?

3. Who are eligible to loan?

Fujifilm Lens Loan Programme is open to all Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents and all who possess a valid Work Permit in Singapore.

4. One-time Registration (for 1st time Loanees)

One-time registration is required for all 1st time Loanees in-person at Fujifilm Studio.

Loanees need to provide supporting documents (1st time) in hardcopy to substantiate their qualifying details:

- Original NRIC or Passport
- Proof of residency status in Singapore (billing details of official bills (original) eg. Bank Statements / Phone Bills / Utilities bill)

- *Loanees can register and produce documents when collecting their lenses from Fujifilm Studios on the actual day itself.*

5. What mode of payment is accepted?

Loan charges can be paid in CASH or NETS only.

6. Is a deposit required?

Yes. A refundable cash deposit of \$150 applies (per lens) for every loan period.

7. How to loan?

- Browse Fujifilm website (www.fujifilm.com.sg/products/consumer-products/digital_cameras/) to identify the lenses to loan. Do note that only selected lenses are available for loan.
- Contact Fujifilm Studio to reserve
 - By phone (6338 4877) / email studio.sg@fujifilm.com
 - In-person to our Studio
- Collect in person from Fujifilm Studio

8. When does my Loan period start and end?

Loanees can collect the lenses 1 day prior to Loan period (from 4pm – 7pm) and to return 1 day after Loan period (By 1pm).

Note: Loanees will be charged a day's loan charge if lenses are not returned by 1pm on the supposed day of return.

9. What range of lenses is available for loan?

Browse Fujifilm website (www.fujifilm.com.sg/products/consumer-products/digital_cameras/) for the specifications of selected lenses to loan, depending on availability. Refer to the table below.

10. How many lenses can I loan each time?

Loanees can borrow up to 2 lenses maximum for every loan period.

11. Can I loan the same lens configuration every time?

Yes but with the following restriction:

Loanees can loan the same lens configuration for a maximum of **2 times** total for the entire loan history records of each individual.

12. Loan Period & Loan Charges

- *Loanees are allowed to loan 2 lenses maximum*
- *Loanees can collect the lenses 1 day prior to loan period (from 4pm – 7pm) and to return 1 day after loan period (Before 1pm).*
- *Loanees will be charged a day's loan charge if lenses are not returned by 1pm on the supposed day of return.*

13. Is Loan Period Extension allowed?

Loan extension is not allowed as Fujifilm seek to make available our range of lenses to a broader group of users.

14. Can I reserve the lenses in advance?

No advanced booking is allowed. Lens loan is subject to availability.

15. What happens in the event of “No show”?

Loanees who failed to turn up may be blacklisted. He / She may be barred from making subsequent loans in future.

16. How do I collect the lenses that I have reserved?

- Collection of lenses is to be made in person. Fujifilm do not allow collection of lenses on behalf of Loanee.
- Loanees need to fill in an official Loan Form (a copy to be given to Loanee) with T&C clearly detailed. Loan Form will need to be signed and endorsed.

17. Lenses Condition Check

All lenses are pre-checked and certified in good condition before loan. However Loanees are encouraged to do a visual and functionality check before signing the Loan Form.

18. How do we determine if a lens is damaged?

Damage Definition

- Any major scratches and scuff marks to the glass of the lenses, water / moisture seepage and impact damage to the lenses body or mechanicals constitute to a damaged lens.
- Minor scratches and scuff marks constitute to normal wear and tear and renters are not liable for it.
- Damage or loss of the Equipment during the rental period is entirely Loanee's responsibility. If Loanee has not notified Fujifilm of any damage within 2 hours of receiving the Equipment, both parties agree that the Equipment was received in good working condition.
- In the event of loss, loss without explanation or stolen equipment, Loanee agrees to pay the full retail cost of the equipment to Fujifilm.
- In the event of damage to the equipment:
 - The deposit of \$150 per lens will be withheld, pending repair costs estimation.
 - Loanee has to top up an additional \$150 on the day of the lens return.
 - In the event that the repair charges are below S\$300, the balance after offset will be returned to the Loanee afterwards.
 - Loanee agrees to pay 100% of actual repair costs deemed necessary by Fujifilm Service Centre or the replacement cost if not repairable.
- Loanees are strongly advised not to attempt to repair the faulty lenses on their own accord.
- Loanees will not be billed on lenses rental charges during period of service unless lenses are not taken in by our Fujifilm Studio for repairs.

19. How do I return the lenses after the Loan period?

- Loanees are to return the lenses to Fujifilm Studio the next day after the loan period expiry date.
- Fujifilm will conduct a physical check on the returned lenses before taking over.
- After satisfactory checks are rendered, Loanees will sign an acknowledgement slip releasing them of further liability.

20. Can I bring the lenses for overseas use?

Fujifilm allows the Loanee to bring the lenses overseas, provided that Loanees exercise adequate 'duty of care' in safe upkeep of the lenses.

21. No Refund / Lenses Exchange Policy

Fujifilm does not provide any refund to Loanees in the event that Loanees decide to cancel the loan or wishes to exchange lenses model. Fujifilm reserves the right to exercise discretion on such matters on case by case basis.
